Welcome to the Summer 2026 Season!

Where the focus is on FUN! We strive to offer young people ages 4–16 the best athletic, artistic and educational camp experience possible!

Drop-off, pick-up and other important information:

Approximately 900 participants arrive at UCC Summer Camps each day. We need your help to ensure the safety and security of all registered children. Please read the following information carefully.

Please note that traffic is **ONE WAY ONLY** in many locations. Drive safely and slowly and watch for children at all times.

You may drop your child off after 8:30 a.m.* – our staff are prepared to greet and care for them at that time. Programs begin at 9 a.m. and extend until 3:30 p.m. daily, Monday to Friday, **including statutory holidays**. (*Golf Camp has an early drop-off at 7:30 am. Please see the Golf section on the following page.)

Check the accompanying maps to find the specific drop-off and pick-up location for the camp(s) in which your child(ren) is (are) registered.

Registration and attendance

At UCC Summer Camps, we maintain strict registration and attendance procedures to help ensure the safety and security of all participants and to properly track each child's personal and medical information as provided to us. Please telephone the camp director in which your son or daughter is registered if he or she will be late or absent. (The number will be provided to you on the first day.) If you know in advance that your child will be absent for part of a session, please inform the Director immediately. If the phone lines are busy, your call will be sent to voicemail – Please leave a message.

Please note that refunds are **not** available within the two weeks before the start of a camp session. Transfers may be made up to two weeks before the start of a camp and are subject to a \$25 administration fee.

Extended Service

UCC Summer Camps Extended Care is available in Summer 2026.

UCC Campus

There are 7 drop-off/pick-up locations around the UCC Campus. All vehicles entering the College grounds **MUST use either the west entrance off Forest Hill Road or the north entrance off Kilbarry Road** (except those destined for Jr. Landsports Camp or Creative Arts Camp, which use the small driveway off Forest Hill Road just north of Lonsdale). Vehicles entering the main driveway from Forest Hill Road at Frybrook must travel in one direction only and exit on Lonsdale Road. **Please do not enter off Lonsdale Road.** The **Kilbarry Road entrance** should be used for those registered in Baseball, Golf, Lacrosse, Sr. Landsports, Sr. Soccer and Leadership Training. All other camps use the Forest Hill Road entrances.

Golf Camp

A shuttle bus service is provided for participants in Golf Camp. The drop-off/pick-up location is at the UCC Campus, accessed by the north entrance off Kilbarry Road. **The bus leaves promptly at 7:30 a.m. and returns by 4:00 p.m. daily.** Please note that there will be no hot lunch option provided at Golf Camp and attendees must bring their own nut-free bagged lunch. Parents will receive a letter by email a week or two before their child is scheduled to attend with further details on Golf Camp.

Food

All participants receive a nutritious lunch, with soup, a hot entrée and a salad bar always available. We cannot accommodate special meal requests, but each dining hall menu offers a vegetarian choice. Due to the danger to children's health from food allergies, we ask that **no food be brought from home.** Children in **Kids Camp** have an afternoon snack provided.





Lost and Found

Each camp maintains its own lost and found. At the end of each session, unclaimed articles are removed to the general Lost and Found, which is located on the second floor of the Arena across from the Camp Office. **At the end of the summer, all remaining articles are donated to a charity.**

Tax Receipts

The confirmation letter you printed off at the time of registration, or received in the mail with these documents, serves as your receipt for income tax purposes.

Further Information

On the first day, your son or daughter will bring home a letter from the Director of the camp in which he or she is registered, which will provide details including the Director's telephone extension, swim days and program-specific information. All participants should bring a bathing suit and towel, sunscreen and a hat and a water bottle. **Do not** bring iPods, jewelry or other valuables as UCC Summer Camps does not assume responsibility for such items. All participants should have their names clearly marked on all clothing, equipment and personal belongings.
